SUMMER & FALL REGISTRATION

For 5 year dancers, we need an early dance shoe (preferably ballet or jazz) by March 1st. Please deliver this shoe to the office in a Zip-loc bag labeled with dancer's name.

COSTUME CHECK & PICTURE WEEK

February 20-24

Costumes will begin going home the week of Valentine's Day, along with any ordered tights and t-shirts. Please try them on as soon as possible to make sure they fit! If they are too big, you can alter them. If they are too small, notify the office immediately. Late order costumes will go home as soon as we receive them. The 2023 Recital Guide will be emailed, providing you with all recital information and details.

We are very excited to announce that individual photos will be taken at the studio February 20-24 by Fluid Frames Dance Photography. Payment will be due at the time of your sitting. This is also when we hold costume check to be sure all costumes are worn the same and you have all accessories, so it is mandatory that you attend even if you choose not to have your photo taken. You may wear your hair as you wish for individual photos. We will not hold classes these days. A link to the photo order form can be found below.

Each dancer has been given an assigned day/time. This schedule can be found in the link in this email blast. Dates and times are firm. We must first clear the previous group of dancers before admitting the next group. Should you be unable to attend your scheduled time, please call or email the office to reschedule. We thank you in advance for your assistance and understanding as we strive to provide an efficient and calm picture week for our dancers and families.

OPEN CURTAIN WEEKS

We are excited to host our second Open Curtain week of the year! This opportunity for you to view your child's class will take place this month during our designated Open Curtain weeks.

- Drop-off will occur as normal and visitors will be invited to stand in the hallway once the class has settled inside the classroom.
- Due to space constraints, please have no more than two visitors per student and strollers are not permitted.
- Parking will be limited - please do not park in the fire lane!
- To protect our students and respect the wishes of all parents, there is to be no videography or photography.
- Classes should run as normal as possible and we ask that you do not interact with the students through the viewing windows. Viewers should also not open the classroom door for any reason.
- You are free to watch all or a portion of your dancer(s) class(es).
- Pick-up will occur as normal and visitors of young students will be asked to wait for their dancer at their appropriate pick-up waiting area.
