RECITAL FEES

Our love of dance is best expressed in our annual recital and the time to plan our 2025 recital is now! All dancers must pay a fee to be in the recital. The recital fee secures our venue, provides one recital T-shirt per dancer, one physical program per dancer as well as a digital program and recording of the recital for each family. Each ticket to the show is \$10 and will be available for purchase in May. Company students participating in the Contemporary Line & Tap Line will receive one All-Show wristband. Recital fees are not refundable. The fee is \$90 on or before October 15th and \$100 after October 15th. Costume

fees are separate. The recital will be held at Houston Christian University (formerly Houston Baptist University) May 30 & 31. Our tech rehearsal will be held May 5 & 6. Your credit card will be charged the recital fee unless you inform us that your child is unable to participate in the recital before October 15th.
