STUDIO CLASSROOM ASSIGNMENTS

Studio classroom assignments can be found on our website under the “Class Schedules” tab. Please note that if a dancer starts on the store side and finishes on the studio side, they will need to be dropped off and picked up accordingly.

STUDIO SIDE

Studios 1, 2, 3 & 4 are on the Studio Side of MDC. Students whose classes take place in these studios will always enter and exit the building through the front office doors that face Gaylord Drive & Memorial High School.

STORE SIDE

Studios 5 & 6 are on the Store Side of MDC. Students whose classes take place in these studios will always enter and exit the building through Memorial Dancewear, located next to Walgreens.

OPEN CURTAIN WEEKS

We are excited to welcome parents into the studio! The first of two opportunities to view your child's class will take place in September. During these weeks, we will open the viewing curtains to our studios and you are welcome to stand in the hallway and watch a portion or all of your child's class(es).

DROP-OFF/PICK-UP POLICY

The safety of our dancers as they enter and exit for classes is a priority for our staff. Please have grace and patience over the next few weeks as everyone - students, parents and staff - navigate these procedures!

- Please enter the parking lot from the entrance closest to the old Kroger building (near Echo Lane) and exit at the end closest to the Chase Bank drive-thru (Mustang Lane).
- Dancers should always wear street shoes outside! Teachers will assist with shoe changes if necessary.
- Parents of dancers 1st Grade & younger are to park and escort dancers to and from the door.

All classes beginning at or before 4pm

- Please line up at the end of the ramp with your dancer. We will open the doors 5 minutes before class time and bring the dancers inside for the first class of the day. We have found that dancers entering the building on their own allows for a much calmer entry and significantly helps prevent most tears!
- Classes will dismiss promptly at their assigned time. We ask that you please come into the office to pick up your dancer.
 - Our entryway is narrow! Please do not crowd the entrance. No strollers! Students will not be released to parent standing outside on the ramp or in the parking lot. The first few weeks will be a little more chaotic until staff begins to recognize dancers' parents.

All classes beginning at or after 4:15pm

- Parents of 1st Grade dancers are to park and escort them to and from the door.
- Dancers 2nd Grade and older should be dropped off in the carpool line and may enter the studio on their own.
- Dancers are to go directly to their classroom at class time. Early dancers (5 minutes or less ONLY) are to wait in the office.
- If a dancer has back-to-back classes, the teacher will make sure they get to the appropriate classroom.

Additional Information

- Dancers are welcome to use the restrooms to change clothes. We are very proud of our studio and ask that you please respect the space.
- Dancers beginning before 4pm are asked to please line up outside once they have changed so that they may enter with their class.
- Parents are welcome to wait in the office. We kindly ask that parents of dancers with a start time before 4pm wait until dancers have gone to class to enter.
- We understand that life and road conditions may dictate too early or late arrival times. We kindly ask that you please try to arrive as close to class start and end times as possible. Please call the office if you are going to be more than five minutes late to pick up your dancer.



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
